The Swimming New Zealand Swim Teacher Award (SNZSTA) is a great opportunity for swim teachers to develop skills and understanding in aquatic education.



- On completion of the SNZSTA course requirements, participants also receive the National Certificate in Recreation and Sport Aquatics (Swim Education)
- SNZSTA covers how people learn, teaching and learning styles and effective communication
- SNZSTA outlines health and safety requirements in and around the aquatic environment.
- SNZSTA provides the tools to assist in the planning and delivering an effective swimming lesson

To complete the award participants are required to:

- attend a one day course participating in theory and practical learn sessions in the class room and pool
- complete a written work book
- gain 20 hours of experience swim teaching
- # write up 10 lessons plans and evaluate these
- be assessed by a Swimming New Zealand Accredited Evidence Gatherer.

Please note that you must be minimum 16 years of age to complete the Swimming New Zealand Swim Teacher Award
