Selection Event	2015 New Zealand Open Long Course Championships, Auckland, 14-17 April, 2015 ("NZ Champs")
Eligibility	<p>To be considered for selection, a swimmer must meet all of the following eligibility criteria:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Be a New Zealand citizen who is eligible to represent New Zealand in the Competition as per FINA General Rule 2 (GR2). 2. Be a registered member of Swimming New Zealand in good standing. 3. Have a signed current Swimming New Zealand Athlete Agreement. 4. Have completed in full and submitted a swimmer availability form prior to the Selection Event. 5. Compete in the NZ Champs unless granted an exemption under the provisions of the criteria by the SNZ Selectors. This exemption will only be granted due to extenuating circumstances. On request of SNZ, evidence shall be provided of the extenuating circumstances, prior to the exemption being considered. 6. Meet the University Sport New Zealand (USNZ) athlete eligibility criteria. 7. Be available to fulfil the Team Commitments as listed below and any additional commitments following selection. 8. Not used or administered any substance which, if it had been detected as being present in the athletes body tissue or fluids, would have constituted doping, or used any prohibited method or committed any other doping offence as defined in SNZ's or FINA's Anti-Doping Bylaw.
Team Commitments	<p>All swimmers selected must:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Comply with the provisions of the SNZ Athletes Agreement at all times 2. Conform to SNZ requirements regarding team participation. This includes, but may not be limited to, providing an acceptable IPP, attendance at a pre-event camp and wearing

<p>Performance Requirement</p>	<p>Criteria for selection for 2015 World University Games, Gwangju, Korea for individual events.</p> <p>To be selected for individual events at the 2015 World University Games (Pool), Gwangju, Korea athletes are required to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Should two or more swimmers achieve the same qualifying time at the selection event then the swimmers second fastest time (and subsequent times should there continue to be a tie) in that event during the Selection Event will be used to determine which swimmer is selected. 5. Relay splits and other split times will not be considered for selection for individual events nor for selection to relays. <p>Nomination for Other Events:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. 	<p>event on the above basis may, on request, based on a time they have swum at the Selection Event, be able to swim in other events where there is an available position.</p> <p>Criteria for Selection for Relay Events:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Selections for relays will be done from within the total team selected for the 2015 World University Games. 2. The final composition of the relay teams will be determined by the coaching staff and team management at the 2015 World University Games, in their sole discretion. 3. The SNZ Selectors philosophy is to ensure the best possible Relay Team is on the blocks representing New Zealand at the 2015 World University Games.
<p>Team Size & Announcement</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Team size for individual events will be in accordance with FISU rules. If the number of swimmers meeting the performance criteria exceeds FISU's limit, the highest ranked swimmers who satisfy the selection criteria will be selected. 2. The selection of the athletes that have met all of the Eligibility and Performance Requirements will be announced on or about the 17th April 2015.
<p>Notes</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. SNZ may amend these selection criteria at any time, by giving reasonable notice to all swimmers eligible for selection. 2. If a swimmer is unable to satisfy SNZ requirements after selection and needs to withdraw from the team, SNZ may at their discretion select the next swimmer who has met all the eligibility and performance requirements. SNZ reserve the right to request that any swimmer being considered for selection under the provisions of this clause undertakes a fitness test, the parameters of which will be determined by the SNZ High Performance Director at his sole discretion. 3. In the event that a swimmer is unable to compete at the Selection Event due to extenuating circumstances, the previous performances in a long course event at a competition acceptable to SNZ Selectors and SNZ High Performance Director, during the period between 1st September 2013 and the Selection Event may be considered by the SNZ Selectors. If the previous performance is to be considered, then the fastest qualifying time, irrespective of where it was achieved, shall have priority. <p>In the event of illness or injury a medical certificate will be requested, indicating the current and future performance impact of the condition.</p> <p>Selection of an athlete, as outlined above, will be subject to confirmation of their satisfactory return to training. This process to include a test (under legitimate competitive</p>

	<p>conditions i.e. starter, turn judges and electronic timing) in the event selected. This test must be performed by a designated date decided by the SNZ High Performance Director. A target time indicating satisfactory progress will be decided by the SNZ High Performance Director and announced to the swimmer by the designated date.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">4. Any Appeals must be made within 1 week of Swimming New Zealand announcing the team.5. Participation at the World University Games will be on a user pays basis.
