If the previous performances are to be considered, then the fastest qualifying time, irrespective of where it was achieved, shall have priority. In the event of illness or injury a medical certificate will be requested, indicating the current and future performance impact of the condition.

Selection of an athlete, as outlined above, will be subject to confirmation of their satisfactory return to training. This process to include a test in the event that they have been selected for. The test must be performed by a designated date decided by the HP Director. A target time indicating satisfactory progress will be decided by the SNZ High Performance Director and announced to the swimmer by the designated date.

Attendance at the Selection Event is on a user pays basis.

Attendance at the Oceania Swimming Championships is on a user pays basis.
