Team	All coaches must:	
Commitments	1. Comply with the provisions of their SNZ Staff Agreement at all times.	
	2. Agree to SNZ requirements regarding team preparation.	
	3. Make themselves available for all team activities designated by SNZ.	
Coach to Swimmer Numbers	The number of support staff selected will vary depending on the type of event and the number and type of swimmers that qualify for the event. The following chart will be used as a guide only for the ultimate number of coaches selected per event.	
	Event	Number of Support Staff to be selected
	Open Pinnacle Events	1 coach for up to six swimmers
	Youth Pinnacle and Non-Pinnacle Open Events	Minimum of 2 support staff for up to 10 swimmers
	Age Group Events	Minimum of 2 support staff for up to 10 swimmers

Selection Considerations	Once a coach or support staff member has been deemed eligible, the following selection considerations will be reviewed before any selection is made.	
	For Open Events the Support Staff selection will be based on the following points;	
	<ul> <li>a. Add value to the Team Environment.</li> <li>b. Ability to work as a team player at all times.</li> <li>c. The coach's prior experience and success as a coach of a New Zealand Team</li> <li>d. SNZ discretion</li> </ul>	
	e. All coach selection and consideration will be based on Olympic Events only	
	In addition, for Youth Pinnacle and Age Group Events the Coach selection will also consider;	
	<ul> <li>a. The FINA points rankings of the swimmers of each available coach.</li> <li>b. If the situation arises where there is a tie on FINA Points the coach with the most swimmers on the team will be selected in the first instance followed by the tied coach on FINA Points.</li> <li>c. If there are more coaching positions available than eligible coaches or one of the coaches that fulfil the above criteria is not deemed suitable by SNZ for the appointment, SNZ may appoint a coach who may not meet every eligibility criterion but is on the Next Generation Coaches List.</li> </ul>	
Head/Lead Coach	SNZ will appoint a Head/Lead Coach for teams where there is more than one staff member selected taking into consideration the following:	
	The Number of Swimmers on team	
	The Ranking of Swimmers on team	
	The Experience of Coach	
Team Leader	For each competition SNZ, may at its sole discretion, appoint a Team Leader who is not actively coaching swimmers.	
Notes	SNZ may amend these selection criteria at any time at its sole discretion.	
	Any appeals must be made within one week of SNZ announcing the team.	
	3. World Ranking - refers to the World Ranking determined by inserting the selected swimmer's fastest time (Olympic Event only) at the Selection Event into the official FINA World Rankings list (Long Course/Short Course – Selection Event dependent) as at December 2017, based on two (2) athlete's performances per nation excluding all New Zealand performances.
