Competition	2014 Junior Pan Pacific Championships, Maui Hawaii, USA – 27th -30th August 2014
Initial Release Date	3 October 2013

Selection Event	2014 New Zealand National Age Group Championships, Wellington, 30 th April – 4 th May, 2014
Eligibility	<p>To be considered for selection, a swimmer must meet all of the following eligibility criteria:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Be a New Zealand citizen who is eligible to represent New Zealand in the Competition as per FINA General Rule 2 (GR2). 2. Be a registered member of Swimming New Zealand in good standing. 3. Have a signed current Swimming New Zealand Athlete Agreement. 4. Compete in the 2014 New Zealand National Age Group Championships unless granted an exemption under the provisions of the criteria by the SNZ Selectors. This exemption will only be granted due to extenuating circumstances. On request of SNZ, evidence shall be provided of the extenuating circumstances, prior to the exemption being considered. 5. Be 13 to 18 years of age on the first day of competition of the 2014 Junior Pan Pacific Championships. 6. Be available to fulfil the Team Commitments as listed below and any additional commitments following selection. 7. Have not previously represented New Zealand and finished in the top 16 in an individual event at one of the following competitions, World Championships (Long Course), Pan Pacific Championships, Commonwealth Games and Olympic Games nor qualified for the 2014 Youth Olympics. 8. Not used or administered any substance which, if it had been detected as being present in the athletes body tissue or fluids, would have constituted doping, or used any prohibited method or committed any other doping offence as defined in SNZ's or FINA's Anti-Doping Bylaw.
Team Commitments	<p>All swimmers selected must:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Comply with the provisions of the SNZ Athletes Agreement at all times.

	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 2. Conform to SNZ requirements regarding team participation. This includes, but may not be limited to, providing an acceptable IPP, attendance at a pre-event camp and wearing team uniform as required. 3. Make themselves available for all team activities designated by SNZ. 4. Not act in such a manner as to bring the athlete or SNZ into public disrepute. 																																										
<p>Performance Requirement</p>	<p>Criteria for selection for pool events for 2014 Junior Pan Pacific Championships, Maui, Hawaii.</p> <p>Individual events:</p> <p>To be selected for individual events at the 2014 Junior Pan Pacific Championships, Maui, Hawaii athletes are required to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Selection Criteria – 2014 Junior Pan Pacific Championships (Pool Events)

	<p>Nomination for Other Events:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> At the sole discretion of SNZ, swimmers who qualify for an event on the above basis may, on request, if they are the first ranked swimmer in another event (based on a time they have swum at the Selection Event), be able to swim in other events where there is an available position. <p>Relays:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Selection for relays for the 2014 Junior Pan Pacific Championships will be made from within the team selected for the 2014 Junior Pan Pacific Championships, Maui, Hawaii. The final composition of the relay teams will be determined by the coaching staff and team management at the 2014 Junior Pan Pacific Championships, Maui, Hawaii in their sole discretion. The SNZ Selectors philosophy is to ensure the best possible Relay Team is on the blocks representing New Zealand at the Junior Pan Pacific Championships.
<p>Team Size & Announcement</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Team size for individual events will be in accordance with the Junior Pan Pacific's Association rules. If the number of swimmers meeting the performance criteria exceeds the limit, the highest ranked swimmers who satisfy the selection criteria will be selected. The selection of the athletes that have met all of the Eligibility and Performance Requirements will be announced on or about the 4th May 2014.
<p>Notes</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> SNZ may amend these selection criteria at any time, by giving reasonable notice to all swimmers eligible for selection. If a swimmer is unable to satisfy SNZ requirements after selection and needs to withdraw from the team, SNZ may at their discretion select the next swimmer who has met all the eligibility and performance requirements. SNZ reserve the right to request that any swimmer being considered for selection under the provisions of this clause undertakes a fitness test, the parameters of which will be determined by the SNZ High Performance Director at his sole discretion. In the event that a swimmer is unable to compete at the Selection Event due to extenuating circumstances, the previous performances in a long course event at a competition acceptable to SNZ Selectors and SNZ High Performance Director, during the period between 1st January 2014 and the Selection Event may be considered by the SNZ Selectors. If the previous performance is to be considered, then the fastest qualifying time, irrespective of where it was achieved, shall have priority.

Selection Criteria – 2014 Junior Pan Pacific Championships (Pool Events)



	<p>In the event of illness or injury a medical certificate will be requested, indicating the current and future performance impact of the condition.</p> <p>Selection of a swimmer, as outlined above, will be subject to confirmation of their satisfactory return to training. This process is to include a test (under legitimate competitive conditions i.e. starter, turn judges and electronic timing) in the event selected. This test must be performed by a designated date decided by the SNZ High Performance Director in consultation with the SNZ High Performance Development Coach. A target time indicating satisfactory progress will be decided and announced to the swimmer by the designated date.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 4. Attendance at the New Zealand National Age Group Championships is on a user pays basis. 5. Participation at the 2014 Junior Pan Pacific Championships will be on a user pays basis.
