Warm-up Procedure

SNZ has a standard warm up procedure for National Competitions to comply with OSH requirements. Details of the Warm-up procedure are on the SNZ website.

Marshalling Process

Marshalling for the Junior Championships will take place in behind the curtain next to the Learn to Swim/Warm Up Pool.

Swimmers will need to marshal 4 events ahead for all races including 50m races.

Conditions

The 2016 New Zealand Zonal Championships will be conducted in accordance with the Swimming New Zealand Regulations as published on 28 August 2015 and FINA Rules. All events will start promptly. Competitors must be ready when called, or the event will start without them.

Protests

Protests must be lodged in accordance with SNZ Regulations. Protests will be as detailed in SNZ Regulation 4. The fee for a protest is \$100.00.

Passes

Passes will be issued to all swimmers, coaches and team managers as detailed on the Regional Association Coaches and Managers Form. Passes will be included in the club packs. Passes must be worn while on pool deck and anyone not wearing a pass will be asked to move to the spectators area.

Pool Access

Swimmers/Coaches/Team Managers:

Access to the pool for swimmers, coaches and managers is via the main entrance to the complex or the fire exits at the Athletics Track end of the pool. Pool staff will be on hand to ensure that passes are being presented. If you do not have a valid pass – you will be required to pay the appropriate admission fee.

Spectators:

Entry to the facility for spectators will be through the “event entry” door to the right of the main entrance, this will be well signposted.

Allocated tickets will be sold online at the [Swimming New Zealand Shop](#). If the ticket allocation is exhausted prior to the meet then there will be no door sales of tickets. Please purchase your tickets online to avoid disappointment on the day.

Spectators are not allowed on pool deck.

Seating

The seating plan will be posted on the SNZ website and around the venue. Clubs/Regions are asked to ensure that swimmers with allocated seating do not procure additional seats. Spectator seating is limited.

Session Programmes and Results

Session programmes will be distributed to Zonal Managers via the Zonal Boxes.

Results

Results for 2016 New Zealand Zonal Championships will be posted as soon as possible in the complex and on the SNZ website at the completion of each session.

Live Results

SNZ will post results for each event on the SNZ website and on the Meet Mobile App.

Disqualifications

Disqualifications will be announced and a copy of the DQ form put in the Zonal Team Manager box.

Timelines

Timelines will be included in Session Programmes. The times shown are approximate and races may start before or after the times indicated. It is the swimmers' responsibility to be at marshalling at the appropriate time (i.e. 4 heats before a swimmers scheduled race).

Session Programmes

Session programmes will be available for purchase at the main entrance of the pool for \$2.00.

Parking

Parking is limited at the venue so where possible please reduce the number of vehicles you travel in to the venue.
