

GETTING A NATIONAL RECORD RATIFIED


If you think you have set a National Record, these are the steps you need to take to have it ratified by SNZ.

1

Login to your MyPage [here](#). If you do not have your login details yet, please get in contact with your club administrator.

In your MyPortal, select the 'Past Meets' button.

This will open up a pop up of all your previous meets. Select the meet where the record was swum.
